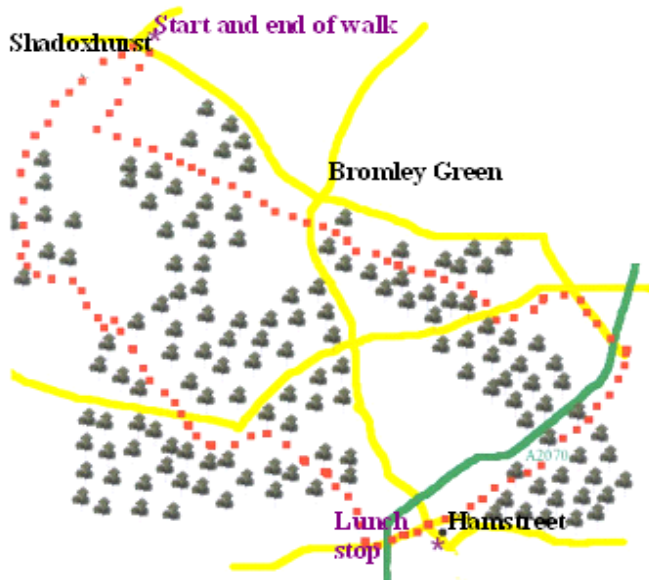
New PCSO for Shadoxhurst
